

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE LEEDS BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH CENTRE**

The Leeds Biomedical Research Centre is located on the first floor of Chapel Allerton Hospital. As the hospital is built on a hill you can access it either directly from the patient car park or from the general reception area on the ground floor.

### **From the main car park**

- Follow the signs to the Chapel Allerton Hospital Clinical Research Centre. This is the first building you see from the main car park - please see diagram below.
- The two car spaces directly in front of the Clinical Research Centre are reserved for research participants only - please see diagram below. For other visitors, there is a pay and display car park in front of the building.



- To gain access you will need your swipe card, if you do not have a access card you can buzz the intercom and if a member of staff is available they will let you in - please see photo below.

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE LEEDS BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH CENTRE**

### **Entering the unit through the main hospital reception area**

- Enter the building through the main entrance.
- Turn left and walk down the corridor right to the end and until you come to a flight of stairs on the right.
- Go up the stairs to the first floor, and turn right. You can also take the lift to the first floor but turn left out of the lift.
- Go straight down the corridor and follow the signs for the Clinical Research Centre.
- The Clinical Research Centre is the last LEFT turn along the corridor before you reach a set of double doors (for staff only).
- To come through the set of double doors you will need your swipe access card to gain entry, if you do not have this you can press the top buzzer on the left hand side of the door if a member of staff is available they will let you in. - see photo below.
