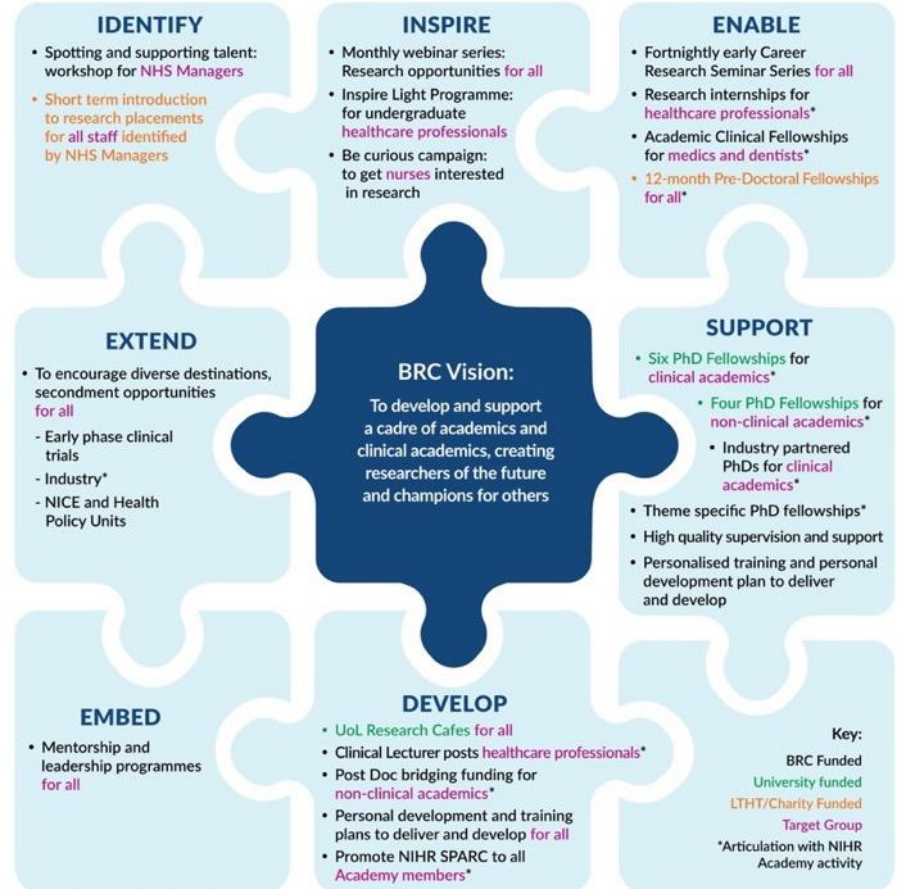
Academic Capacity Development

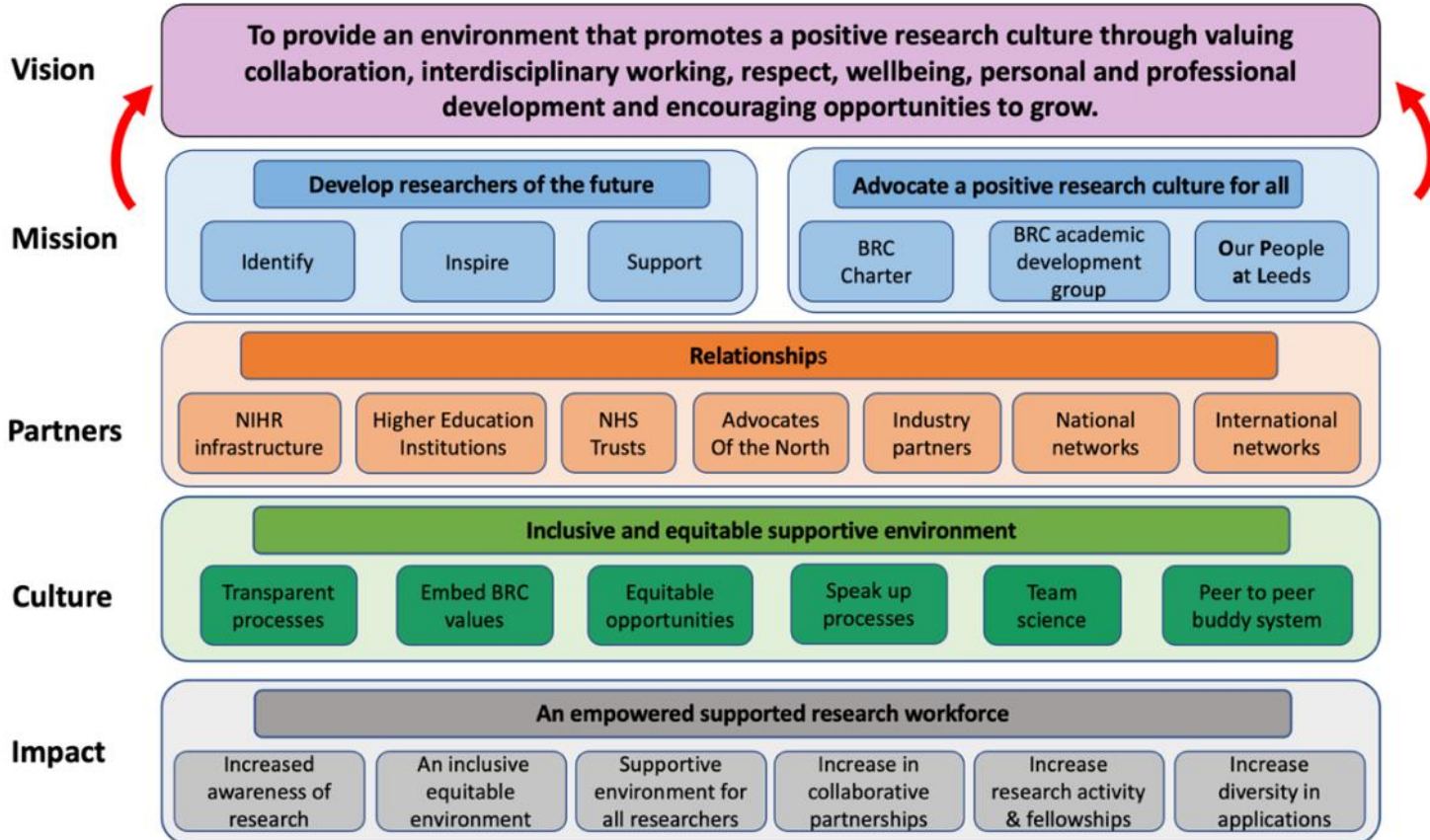

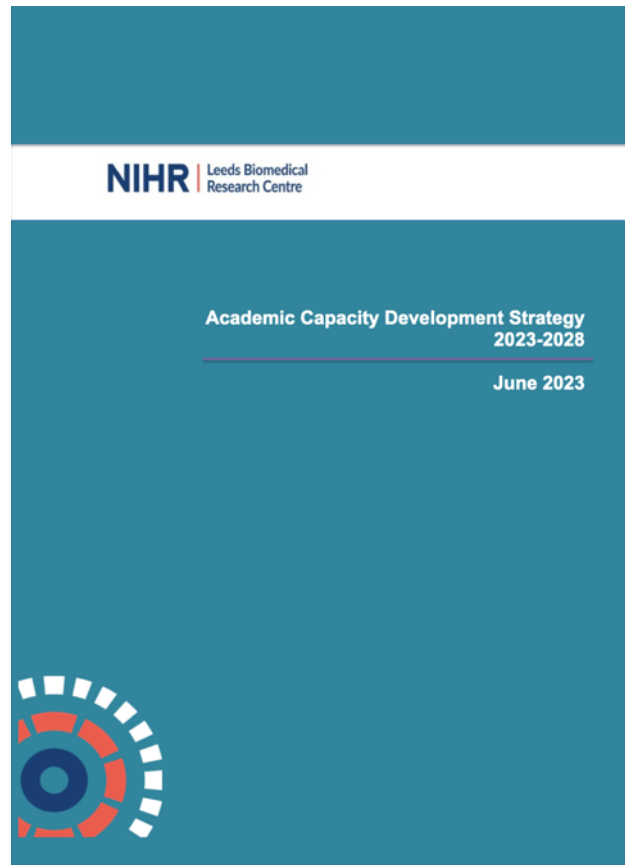

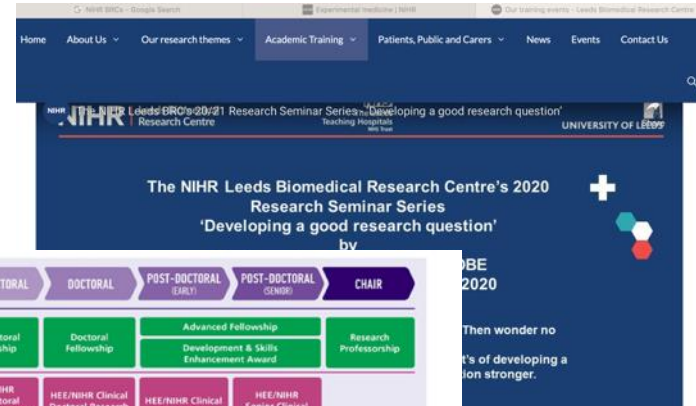
