Patient Directions & Access Guide — Temporary Route Update

IMPORTANT NOTICE: TEMPORARY ENTRANCE CLOSURE

Please note that due to essential construction work, the direct external entrance to the Biomedical Research Centre (BRC) is currently blocked off and inaccessible. All patients, visitors, and study participants must enter via the Chapel Allerton Hospital Main Entrance and use the internal route detailed below until further notice.

Parking & Charges

The patient and visitor car park is situated directly at the front of the hospital site (Pay & Display):

- Up to 2 hours: £2.80 | Up to 4 hours: £5.50
- Up to 6 hours: £8.60 | Up to 24 hours: £12.70+

If you experience any mobility difficulties or get lost, please speak to any member of hospital corridor staff or ask at the main reception desk. Mobility aids and manual wheelchairs are available to borrow at the main entrance. You may also call the phone number listed on your appointment invitation letter.

Step-by-Step Internal Directions to the LBRC

Please follow these structured directions once you enter the hospital main building to navigate smoothly to the unit:

Step 1: Enter via the Main Entrance

Enter the hospital building through the sliding doors at the front main entrance (situated under the weather-protection canopy). Once inside, you will find a hand sanitizing station on the right wall. The General Enquiries reception counter is located straight ahead, roughly 4 meters from the entrance.



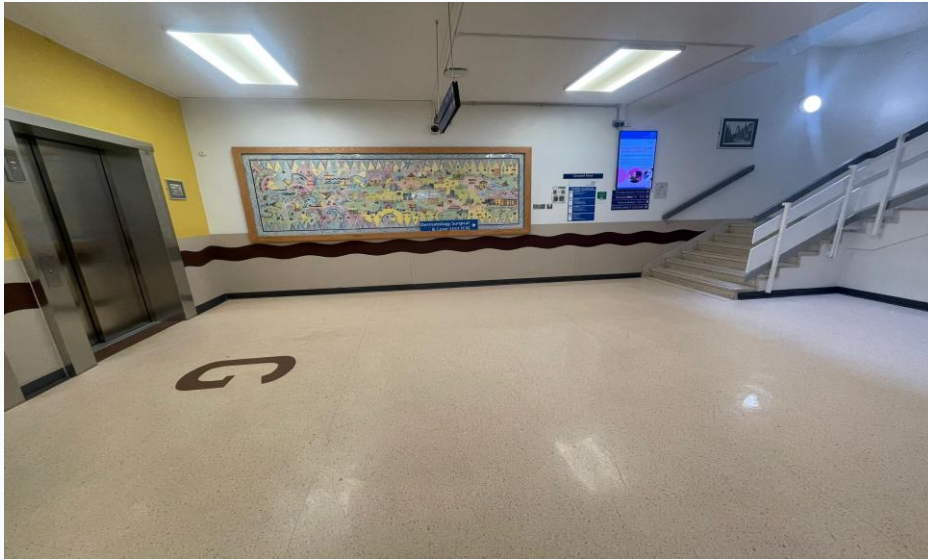
Step 2: Turn Left and Proceed Down the Main Corridor

Immediately before reaching the main reception counter, turn left into the wide horizontal corridor. Walk straight down this corridor without turning off. You will pass the accessible and shared standard public toilets on your left side. Keep walking straight until you reach the very end of the corridor.



Step 3: Locate Lifts or Stairs at the End of the Hallway

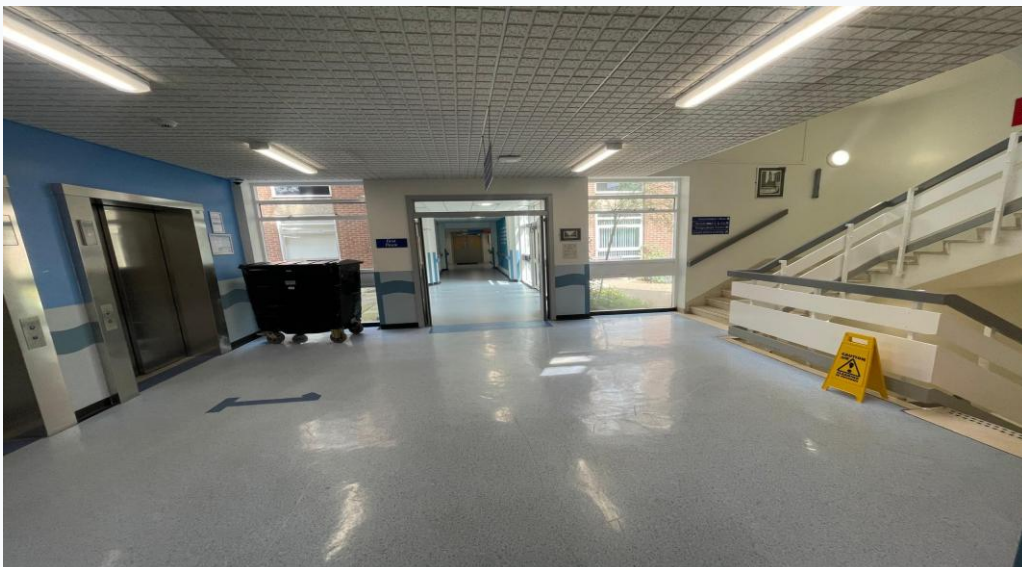
At the absolute end of the main corridor, you will arrive at the Block 2 vertical access lobby. Here, you will find two public lifts located on your left-hand side and a flight of stairs on your right-hand side. You can use either the lifts or the stairs to reach the First Floor.



Step 4: Exit onto the First Floor Corridor

Upon arriving at the First Floor, your turn will depend on the method of travel you chose:

- If you used the Lift: Exit the lift car and turn left into the corridor.
- If you used the Stairs: Walk up to the first-floor landing and turn right into the corridor.



Step 5: Follow the Hallway and Turn Left for the BRC Entrance

Follow the corridor straight down, following the visual signage pointing toward the Biomedical Research Centre. Walk until you see a final left turn just before a set of staff-only double doors. Take this left turn, which opens directly into the internal hospital entrance to the Biomedical Research Centre.



Step 6: Arrival at the Unit Doors and Buzzer System

You are now at the internal entrance doors of the LBRC. On the left wall beside the door, you will find an intercom panel. Please press the top buzzer button, and a member of our clinic reception team will speak to you and release the door lock to welcome you inside.
